## NEW FOR 2010!

Welcome to the 2010 T-Ball, Baseball & Softball season. With your help, it will be a great season for both parents and players.

**Online Registration** – Again this year, Online Registration will be open from 1/04/10 – 2/14/10. This proved to be a more efficient way to help both our parents and PHBSA to streamline the registration process. With online registration, payment can be made online by credit card, mailed in, or dropped off at the in-person registration. Regardless of the method of payment, we encourage all participants to register online. All payments must be postmarked within 7 days of their online registration date in order to hold the spot. Any payments not postmarked by the required date will be considered late and the player will be placed on a waiting list and subject to any late fees.

**Volunteers** – We need help in many areas during the season. Our volunteer needs will be listed on the registration form and on sign up sheets at registration please take a moment to select an area that best fits you and your family. We understand that everyone is very busy these days but if each family helps for just one or two hours, our program would improve greatly.

**Pirate Travel Baseball** - Tryouts for the 9U – 13U age groups were held in August 2009. For the 2011 season, they will be held August 15 & 22, 2010, with August 29 as a rain date. Please check the website in July for times. Players must attend one of two tryouts to be eligible for a team.

**Umpires** - We are in need of many umpires for our baseball and softball games. Training will be mandatory for all participants before the season begins. Applicants must be 13 years old by May 1, 2010. We also welcome all adults to apply. Please see our website for an online umpire application and details on the umpire clinics.

**Coaching** - **Any interested coaches MUST fill out a coaching application, which is a section within the online player registration.** Please understand that prior coaches will have first consideration in divisions that have more coaches than teams created. We will be selecting the head coaches and assigning assistant coaches. We will allow the head coach to select **ONE** assistant coach on their application, however, we can make no guarantees.

**Travel Sponsors** - **Travel team sponsors are needed.** The sponsor fee for travel is \$325. Travel sponsor applications are available on our website.

**Mustang League** –We will determine if there are enough participants to support this league after registration. Last year we were able to combine with SELCRA in Brighton and will look at that again this year if needed. Due to our limited field availability, this division's game days and times will be determined later. If we do combine with SELCRA, all scheduling of games will be done by them and can be played any day of the week (Mon-Sat). Please note that SELCRA's season runs from middle of June to mid July.

**Softball Divisions** –We will determine if there are enough participants to support these divisions after registration. Last year we were able to combine with SELCRA in Brighton and will look at that again this year if needed. If we do combine with SELCRA, all scheduling of games will be done by them and can be played any day of the week (Mon-Sat). Please note that SELCRA's season runs from middle of June to mid July.

## Important 2010 Registration Information

- You must register online or attend the in-person registration session to register. **Absolutely no mail in registrations will be accepted.**
- Late registrations will only be accepted if openings exist within the appropriate age division. A **\$25 late fee will apply to each in-person registration accepted after January 30<sup>th</sup> and to each online registration accepted after February 14<sup>th</sup>. NO exceptions.**
- **PHBSA does not honor any requests for ride sharing or friends playing together.**
- T-Ball players must be 4 years old on April 30, 2010 to be eligible to play.
- Players will not be allowed to play up or down a division.
- Divisions are subject to change if a minimum of 48 players is not reached.
- **Refund Policy: Refunds (less \$25 handling fee) will be granted through February 28, 2010.**
- **Fees: A \$25 return check fee for non-sufficient funds applies.**

## **We have Google Checkout for On-line Payment -NO ONLINE PAYMENT FEES IN 2010!**

Google checkout will enable parents to pay their player's fee by major credit card online. Parents that attend of the in-person registration and would like to pay by credit card must request the Google Checkout payment method at registration. Each parent will be given a registration number and must visit our website within 48 hours of registration to pay by credit card. In-person registrants that do not complete the on line payment within the 48 hour time frame will not be placed on a team in the league and their registration spot will not be held.
